
Number of Black or African-American designated institutions in decline

Analysis is based on Black or African-American designated banks and thrifts headquartered in the U.S.

Minority designated institutions identified by the FDIC are based on "either (1) a concentration of ownership among members of a certain minority group, or (2) a concentration of Board membership among that minority group by an institution that primarily serves that minority group." Inclusion on the list is voluntary.

Total assets are based off regulatory fillings by minority designated banks and thrifts.
