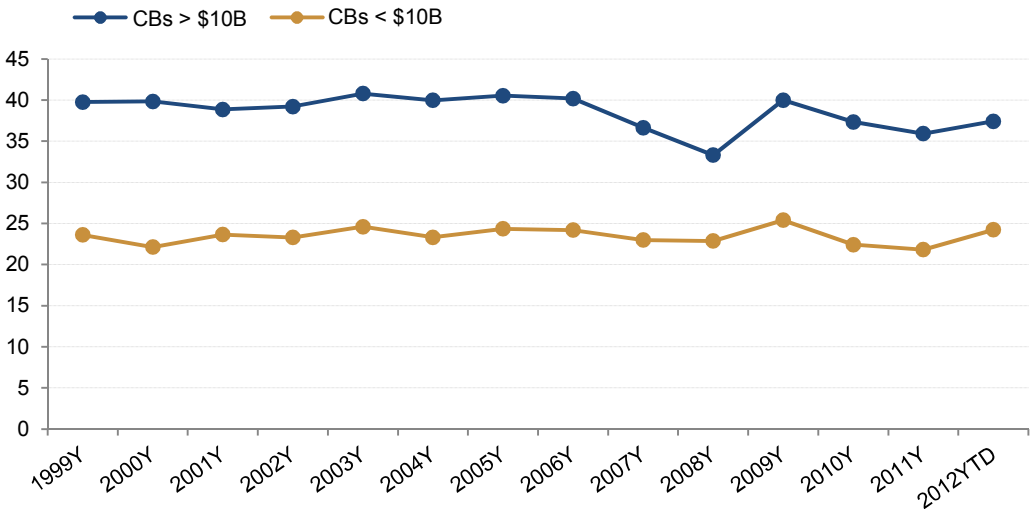


# US commercial bank noninterest income as a portion of operating revenue (%)
